Thank you for your interest in applying for a permit to do work on land under the control of the New York Power Authority. This packet includes general instructions, a permit application, and an example of the required insurance forms. Please note that this information is general and not specific to any current proposed project. You may be required to supply additional materials, depending on the specific application. Electronic submission of your application is preferred.

Typically, the completed application is returned accompanied by the following:

- A detailed scope of work referencing all aspects the project.
- A full set of stamped construction drawings, if applicable.
- An aerial photograph depicting the intended area of use.
- Clearances to any transmission lines, if applicable.
- Excavation/disturbances over underground features (i.e., conduits), if applicable.
- A Health and Safety Plan (HASP) specific to this project and job, following this template:

- Any other information the applicant feels would assist in our review.

The insurance requirements listed below MUST be sent with the application packet. Your application is not considered complete and cannot be reviewed or drafted without the following:

- A completed ACORD form. Typical limits are:
 - \$2M in commercial general liability
 - \$1M in business auto
 - \$3M in umbrella/ excess liability.
 - Professional Services, Watercraft, Riggers and/or Pollution Liability may be added by our reviewers, if any are deemed applicable.
- A certificate evidencing NYS worker's comp insurance.
- Additional Insured Endorsement (example attached). The specific additional endorsement **MUST** be supplied.
- Waiver of Subrogation Endorsement (example attached). The specific additional endorsement **MUST** be supplied.

Submission of complete and comprehensive applications will aid in expediting the issuance of permits.
